# Test-taker is not mandated to select an Adult Ed Center

- Students should be encouraged by their teacher to select their Adult Ed Center in GED.com to share their scores

- If a test-taker does NOT select an Adult Ed Center, scores will not be shared

# Let's look at ways to use this information

- Students select an adult education center when:
  - they need to locate a center and get more information from you
  - or when they are your student and want to share their scores with you
- It's important to review this information and determine what each person needs
  - If they are not your student, they are needing you to reach out to them and welcome them to join you
  - If they are your student, you need to change their status so you can tell which entries are potential students needing to be contacted
- You will need access to GED Manager (we will cover how to get this access)



- Adult Educators can sort by one student or groups of students and export the results – sorting by date, enrollment status or credential status
- Educators can edit the status of a student from ‘Interested’ to ‘Contacted,’ ‘Dismissed,’ or ‘Enrolled’ and write notes about the students





# Process for getting access to GED Manager

- Each state has different guidelines on who can get access
- Email your State Relationship Manager or request access at [operations@GED.com](mailto:operations@GED.com)
- Email address needs to be different than the one you may have used to create a GED.com account

# New GED Manager™ users will receive a welcome email and training document

- Once the Adult Ed Center user names and emails have been entered into GED Manager™ by GED Testing Service, the new users will receive a welcome email and training document on how to access their students' scores
- Adult Ed Centers will be able to see only scores for their students at their location and not others
- All students from a specific Center may not have viewable scores if each student doesn't authorize the Center to have access
- Access to student scores will be available to the Adult Ed Center user as soon as the student selects the Adult Ed Center in GED.com.
  - The student may or may not have a completed test (GED Ready® or a GED® test) when they select their Adult Ed Center
  - Under-age students will not show in GED Manager

# GED Manager Accounts

- User accounts will be inactivated after 180 days of not logging into GED Manager. If you attempt to log in after this period of time you will be notified that your account is inactive
- Inactive users that still need GED Manager will have to go through a process of being re-approved for access.






