
Manage Student → Manage GEDPrep Connect Enrollment



- Adult Educators can sort by one student or groups of students and export the results sorting by date, enrollment status or credential status
- Educators can edit the status of a student from 'Interested' to 'Contacted,' 'Dismissed', 'Enrolled', or 'Credentialed' and write notes about the students



Important to know who is an enrolled student vs. an interested student



Educators will also see students' information who are interested in a program but not currently enrolled

It is up to the adult education program to reach out to those students to get them to enroll

It makes running reports of your current students much easier



Tips for outreach to interested students

- Make sure you update the status of the students in your program
- Successful programs have teachers assigned to monitor GEDPrep Connect enrollment and reach out to Interested students
- Do not be afraid to call or email students they shared their contact information for a reason!
- Consider using Remind.com to streamline outreach

Problems to Solve

- GED Ready voucher code spreadsheets are an administrative headache.
 - Difficult to distribute to educators

Updated Dashboard


Student now has an activity card on the home page of their GED account telling them they have an Language Arts In-Person test assigned. Link launches the GED Ready test.

Activity Card in Student Account

When student logs in to their GED.com account they see an activity card with the GED Ready subject that has been assigned to them. They click **Access** to launch the test.



When assigning a test the student will be able to **Schedule** the test from the activity card. They will still be able to choose the language.

Just click "unassign" in status column of Manage Assignments screen.



Extended Response Scoring Tool

The GED Ready® Practice Test for language arts gives students a chance to practice their writing skills by completing an Extended Response (ER) question. This tool is designed to help you score and provide meaningful feedback to your students about their written response, located in their GED Ready Score Report.

How to use this tool
